Murano is special finish type 'designer' leather, machine buffed to give a soft hide base then a special blend of oils and waxes are applied to the top coat to achieve a cracked and distressed finish. The leather surface is designed to crack open in initial use to reveal the rich base colours and give a definite 'aged & distressed' character for the furniture. Popular in both domestic and contract settings, a designers favourite.
